Appellation :	Saint-Émilion Grand Cru
Area :	6 hectares (among the 15 hectares of the vineyard)
Terroir :	Sandy-clay soil on ferrous blue clay veins
Grape varieties :	100% Merlot
Average age of the vine :	30 years
Cultivation technique :	No herbicides, tillage, cover crops, disbudding, leaf stripping, thinning...
Harvest :	By hand from 23 rd September to 5 October.
Yield :	39,85 hl / ha
Winemaking :	In temperature-controlled concrete vats. Alcoholic fermentation and maceration during 25 to 30 days with light pumping over and released.
Ageing :	15 months in new oak barrels.
Bottling :	20 th April 2020
Production :	28 822 bottles, 1 240 magnums
